Language Arts

This week, we have been learning about the sound (t). Now, students are able to recognize (t) sound, write it using the right formation and giving words starting with it.

This week, we have been working on (my feelings). We have been trying to teach the students how to express their feelings in an appropriate way. Students have been learning about how they could feel in different situations.
